Part 2. Students watch the first part of the video, up to where the speaker explains how astronomy changed their view of the world (0:34).

Part 3. Students discuss the questions.

Part 4. Students watch the second part of the video (0:34 to the end).

Part 5. Students match each experience (1-4) from the video with the feeling (A-D) it created.
