Vocabulary & speaking

Part 1. Students read the quotes from the video and try to explain what each expression in bold means.

Streets alive → full of people, movement, noise, and energy

Sense of community → a feeling of connection, belonging, and togetherness with others

Unleash their inner child → allow themselves to act playfully and freely, without worrying about rules or judgement

Embrace new beginnings → accept and feel positive about starting something new or moving on

Come together → meet, gather, or join as a group, often for a shared purpose

Rich cultural heritage → long-standing traditions, customs, and history passed down through generations

Fuels inspiration and innovation → encourages new ideas, creativity, and original thinking
