### The People Who Shape Us – Advanced (C1-C2)

**Part 1.** Students choose the quote that resonates most with them – or the one they instinctively push back on and explain why.

**Part 2.** Choose one option in each pair, giving a reason or example.

**Part 3.** Students discuss the questions.

**Part 4.** Students look at the list of people, and choose three who have shaped them in some way. Students then tell their partner who they chose and why.

**Part 5.** Students match the terms to their meanings and use three of the expressions to describe someone who has shaped them.

### Answer key:

1. To leave a mark on someone
2. To hold someone to a higher standard
3. To bring out the best in someone
4. To see something in someone
5. To carry someone with you
6. To look up to someone

**Part 6.** Students think of one person who has genuinely shaped who they are and build a portrait of them using the prompts.

**Part 7.** Students decide whether they agree, disagree, or partly agree with each statement.

**Part 8.** Students discuss the questions.

**Part 9.** Students take a guess at their partner's answers, and then check the answers with them.

**Part 10.** Students discuss the questions.

**Part 11.** Students think of someone who has shaped them – someone they've never properly thanked, or someone they can no longer reach. Using the prompts, students describe what they'd say to them if they could.

Students complete the sentences in their own words.
