Sofia: Good idea! And in the evening, let's go to a samba club and dance the night away.

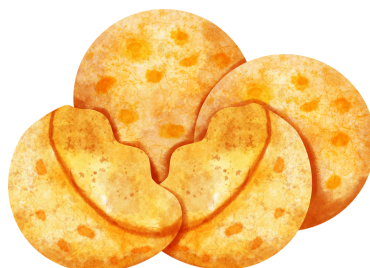
Liam: Yes! Everyone here seems bursting with energy.
