Teaching Tip (optional but recommended)

Encourage students to justify their choices, especially when they disagree. For example:

- *"Photography can be social if you do it with friends."*
- *"Gaming is relaxing for some people, but stressful for others."*

Part 3. Students discuss the questions.

Part 4. Students choose one option and explain their choice.

Part 5. Students read the statements and say if they agree, disagree, or are not sure. Encourage students to explain their choice.

Part 6. Students choose one statement that feels true for them and explain.

Part 7. Students read the situations and discuss the questions.

Part 8. Students complete the sentences with their own ideas.

Part 9. Students rank each aspect from 1 (most important) to 5 (least important) when choosing a hobby. Encourage students to explain their choices.

Part 10. Students think about their childhood and life now and discuss each of the points.
