Part 1. Students circle where they would sit on the scale and explain their choice to a partner. Students then discuss the questions.

Part 2. Students choose one option in each pair, giving a reason or example.

Part 3. Students decide which statements feel true for them and explain why.

Part 4. Students discuss the questions.

Part 5. Students match the terms to their meanings. Then students choose three expressions and use them to tell their partner something true about themselves.

Answer key:

1. Open up
2. Recharge
3. Put on a performance
4. Overstimulated
5. Blend into the background
6. Drained
7. Feed off the energy
8. Self-contained

Part 6. Students read each situation and choose the response that feels most like them.

Part 7. Students decide whether they agree, disagree, or partly agree with each statement and explain their thinking.

Part 8. Students guess their partner's answers to each question, and then check how well they know them.

Part 9. Students discuss the questions.

Part 10. Students think of a time when they were in a social situation that felt uncomfortable or out of character for them and tell their partner about it.
