Part 1. Students discuss whether they have any of the other things in the boxes.

Part 2. Choose one option in each pair, giving a reason or example.

Part 3. Students read the statements, discuss which ones feel true for them and explain why.

Part 4. Students discuss the questions.

Part 5. Students choose the three reasons that are most true for the things they keep. Then they compare with their partner.

Part 6. Students match each expression to its meaning. They then choose two expressions and use them to talk about something they own.

Part 7. Students read the situations and choose the answer that sounds most like them.

Part 8. Students discuss whether they agree, disagree, or partly agree with each statement.

Part 9. Students imagine they could bring one object from home to show the class. Using the prompts, students describe it to their partner.
