Warm-up

Part 1. Students discuss which word comes to mind first when they think about travel and explain why.

Part 2. Students complete the sentences in their own way and explain their choices.

Part 3. Students choose one of the situations and tell a short story.

Video activity

Part 1. Tell students they are about to watch a video about a capsule hotel in Tokyo. Before watching, students discuss the questions.

Part 2. Students watch the video. While watching, ask them to decide:

- the best detail
- the worst detail
- the weirdest detail

Part 3. Students discuss the questions.

Vocabulary & speaking

Part 1. Students read the quotes and try to guess the meaning of the words and phrases in bold.

Trippy – strange or confusing in an interesting or surprising way

Toasty – pleasantly warm, sometimes a bit too warm

Stuffy – uncomfortable because the air feels warm and stale

Squeeze in – to find time for something when you are very busy

Light sleeper – someone who wakes up easily from noise or movement

Part 2. Students choose the best word or phrase.

Part 3. Students complete the sentences with their own ideas.

Part 4. Students choose one and explain their choice.
