Warm-up discussion

Part 1. Students discuss the questions.

Part 2. Students read the menu items and discuss the questions.

Vocabulary & speaking

Part 1. Students read the mini-dialogues, paying attention to the phrases in bold.

Part 2. Students match each phrase to its function.

Answer key:

1. Asking for time – **Could we have one more minute?**
2. Making an order with a small change – **Could I have...but without...?**
3. Making an order + checking something – **I'd like..., but can I ask...?**
4. Asking for a suggestion – **What do you recommend...?**
5. Asking about sides – **Does this come with...?**
6. Asking to replace one item with another – **Can I swap... for...?**

Part 3. Students imagine they're ordering in a restaurant and complete the sentences using the phrases from the previous exercise.

Part 4. Students discuss what they would say in each of the situations. Encourage students to use the useful phrases.

Part 5. Students choose a dish from exercise 2 and create a natural-sounding order using the useful phrases.

Part 6. Students choose one option and explain their choice.

Part 7. Students reflect on eating out in their culture using the questions.
