Warm-up

Part 1. Students discuss the questions.

Part 2. Students look at the photos and discuss the questions for each one.

Part 3. Students rank the transport options from 1 (best) to 6 (worst) for each situation. Students then compare their choices.

Vocabulary & speaking

Part 1. Students read the conversations and guess the meaning of the bold words. Then students say if this has happened to them.

Platform: the area where you wait for a train

Fare: the money you pay for transport

Crowded: full of people

Directions: instructions on how to get somewhere

Ticket: paper or digital proof of payment

Part 2. Students say what they would do in each of the situations.

Part 3. Students discuss the situations. For each one, students decide what they would ask, using the useful phrases.

Part 4. Students discuss the questions.

Part 5. Students discuss each statement and say whether it is true for them or not, and explain why.

Reflection

Students finish the sentences with their own ideas.
